


2008 General Election for U.S. Senator Coleman-Franken Margin by Precinct Official Results

Results certified by State Canvassing Board on January 5, 2009 following an administrative recount. Improperly rejected absentee ballots were included by order of MN Supreme Court. Certificate of election was issued June 30, 2009 after resolution of election contest.

The Coleman-Franken margin is the difference between the percent of total votes cast for Norm Coleman and the percent of total votes cast for Al Franken in each precinct. For example, in Hastings W-2 P-2, Coleman received 40.00% and Franken received 40.43% of the total votes in the precinct, so the margin is 0.43%.

*Dean Barkley of the Independence Party received the most votes in ten precincts around the state. Those precincts are labeled "IP" with Barkley's percentage.
