Minnesota Rules Citations

M.R. 8210.0050:

- All materials mailed in connection with [mail] voting must bear the official United States Postal Service Election Mail insignia.
- All envelopes used in connection with [mail] voting must bear a legend indicating the ballot category enclosed, in no smaller than 8-point type. The ballot category for this envelope is "registered"
- M.R. 8210.0710, subp. 2: Envelopes must be white in color with black ink
- M.R. 8215.0500, subp. 6: The checklist for mail voters must be printed on the exterior of the envelope.
- M.R. 8210.0710, subp. 1: The secretary of state shall provided samples of the layout of the front and the back of the envelope.
- M.R. 8210.0720, subp. 3: Mailing Address
- Envelope must include mail address
- Address block must be located in lower right one-quarter of envelope
- May be addressed to county auditor or municipal clerk
- M.R. 8210.0720, subp. 4: USPS-approved marks to identify ballot materials must be printed on envelope as specified by USPS instructions.
- M.R. 8210.0720, subp. 5: "OFFICIAL [MAIL] BALLOTING MATERIAL—FIRST CLASS MAIL" Must be printed in 18-point bold type and inside a box.
- M.R. 8210.0720, subp. 6: County auditor or municipal clerk may affix the return address to upper left-hand corner of envelope
