2i. With regard to fiscal 2022, we have chosen B Lab's Impact Assessment tool.

ii A and B. How the Minnesota Center for Systemic Constellations has contributed to the general benefit, the extent to which and the ways in which the Minnesota Center for Systemic Constellations has created general public benefit are described in the attached B-Lab Impact Assessment questionnaire.

iiC. Our efforts to pursue or create general public benefit were hindered by the serious illness and eventual death of one of the co-founders, Michael McElwee. Dr. McElwee was already undergoing treatment for memory related issues, and then was diagnosed in April, 2022 with small cell lung cancer. He succumbed to his illness on August 16, 2022. Katherine Curran, the other co-founder and his spouse, scaled back operations during his cancer illness and after his death, until the end of the year.

3. This is not the first report we have filed.

4. We used the same version of the B-Lab Impact Assessment as in 2021 – the B-Lab Quick Impact Assessment.

4.i We applied the standard in the same way as last year.


