

Annual Benefit Report of AUSZI GBC

A Minnesota General Public Benefit Corporation

AUSZI GBC was converted from a corporation to a GBC on December 22, 2022 and has ever since operated as a General Benefit Corporation under Minnesota's Public Benefit Corporation Act (the "Act"). 2023 was AUSZI GBC's second year in business and first full year in operation.

Pursuant to Section 304A.101 of the Act, AUSZI GBC's general public benefit purpose as stated in its Articles of Incorporation is: The purpose of the Corporation shall include creating a material positive impact on society and the environment, taken as a whole, from the business and operations of the Corporation.

To carry out this purpose, AUSZI GBC provided a framework of systems and processes to its subsidiaries. Standardization of platforms helps subsidiaries focus on their core business operations, at the same time maintaining alignment and reducing duplication.

Third Party Standard

Certification: the Board of Directors certifies that is has chosen a third-party standard required by Minn. Stat. §304A.301 to guide its operations. The third-party standard applies to AUSZI GBC's operations described in this report.

Selection of Standard: B Labs' B Corporation certification program was selected in 2022 and AUSZI GBC continued to rely on that standard during the 2023 operating year.

Application of Standard: In accordance with this third-party standard, AUSZI GBC has done the following to pursue a general public benefit:

In accordance with this third-party standard, AUSZI GBC has created the following general public benefit: AUSZI GBC obtained an overall impact score of 81 when the median score of ordinary business is 50.9. Because AUSZI GBC uses an Impact Business Model they are intentionally designed to create a specific positive outcome for its workers, community, environment and customers.

The following circumstances hindered AUSZI GBC's efforts to pursue or create a general public benefit: there were no significant hinderances.
