

MAKE YOUR **VOTING PLAN**

I am eligible to vote

- 🕨 I am a U.S. citizen
- I am at least 18 years old on Election Day
- I have been a resident of Minnesota for 20 days
- I am not currently incarcerated for a felony conviction
- I am not under a court order that revokes my right to vote

Don't forget!

- To arrange for transportation
- Confirm polling location
- Get a witness (if voting by mail)
- Notify anyone who may need to know (work, childcare, school, etc.)

I am not registered to vote (choose option 1, 2 or 3)

- **1.** I have a driver's license, state or tribal ID with my current address: (choose one)
 - I will register online at: mnvotes.gov/register
 - I will download a registration form at <u>mnvotes.gov</u> and print and mail the form to my county office.
 - I will register when I vote in person.
- **2.** I DON'T have a current driver's license, state or tribal ID, but I do have:
 - **A.** An expired driver's license or license with an old address, a state ID, a passport, or a current ID from a Minnesota school.
 - **B. AND** a bill dated within 30 days of the election for phone, TV, internet, utilities, bank account, credit card, mortgage, or lease.
 - I will bring the items above to vote early in person.
 - I will show the items above to my witness when I vote by mail.
 - I will bring the items above to my polling place on Election Day.
- 3. I DON'T have a valid ID or bill
 - I will visit <u>www.sos.mn.gov/elections-voting/register-to-vote/</u> <u>register-on-election-day</u> to check how to register to vote on Election Day.
